Page 366: Pickett's attack on Federal lines occurred on July 3, not July 2, 1863.

Page 66: The definition of monarchy in the margin should read, "Inherited political rule by a royal family."

Page 84: The answer to the first question in "Let's Remember" under "Chapter 4 Review" is not found in the text.

Page 131: St. Gregory of Nyssa, not Nissa.

Page 133: St. John Chrysostom lived from ca. 347-407, not 550-407.

Page 162: In the last paragraph of the sidebar, "The Heroic Hildebrand," "German and Italy" should be *Germany and Italy*.

Page 177: The typical account of the life St. Thomas Aquinas' life has Thomas called the "Dumb Ox" by his fellow students, not by a boyhood teacher.

Page 188: The last full sentence on this page should read, "Europe was tortured..." not "Europe was be tortured...."

Page 192: The year date in the first sentence of the third paragraph of the section "Cervantes" should be 1575, not 1557.

Page 193: In the sidebar on Don Quixote, Dulcinea should be called a peasant girl, not a barmaid.

Page 210: In the "Genghis and Kublai Khan" sidebar, the dates for Genghis Khan should be 1162-1227.

Page 233: The atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima on August 6, 1945. Another atomic bomb was dropped on Nagasaki on August 9, 1945.

Page 254: The picture caption identifies Shah Jahan. The text spells the name as Jehan. Both spellings are acceptable.

Page 266: Map caption should read – The Kingdoms of Western Africa

Page 285: The picture caption should read, Grand Prince Dimitri, instead of “Grand Duke Dimitri.” In the first sentence of the first full paragraph should have Dimitri rather than “Dimitry.”

Page 306: The first full sentence on the page should read – “Established each approximately **one** day’s journey apart...”

Page 309: At the bottom of the page, the text says both Washington and Jefferson freed their slaves after the Revolution. Jefferson did not free his slaves.

Page 311: The Louisiana Purchase did not give the United States access to the Pacific Ocean. The United States obtained the Oregon Territory in the 1840s, not the 1820s.

Page 315: In the last sentence of the top jump paragraph, the phrase, “the called the Confederate...” should be “then called the Confederate...”

Page 316: Last sentence should read – “Bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes...”

Page 319: In the first full paragraph in the section, “The Geography of Latin America,” “Chili” should be Chile.
