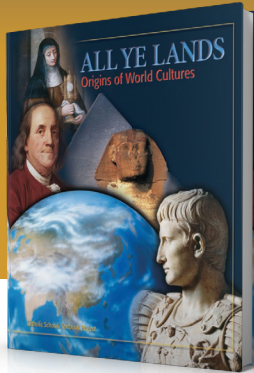


Teacher Resources Sampler

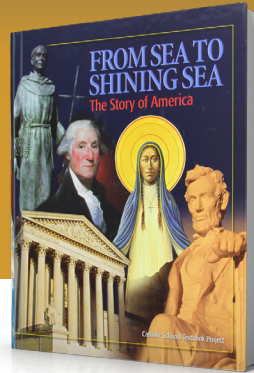

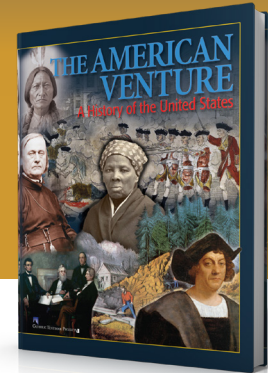
